Dominion Hill boasts a captivating history that enchants all who visit. In 1928, the charismatic **Cyrus Curtis** acquired a picturesque farm as a summer refuge for his beloved daughter. Curtis's life is a true rags-to-riches tale; he left formal education behind at the tender age of nine and embarked on his entrepreneurial journey by launching his first newspaper at just fifteen.

By the turn of the 20th century, he stood as one of America's most prominent publishers, having founded two iconic magazines of that era: the esteemed "The Saturday Evening Post" and the elegant "Ladies' Home Journal."







Following Curtis, the estate came into the hands of **General James Van Fleet**, a figure of greatness renowned for his unmatched military accomplishments. This illustrious general holds a treasure trove of accolades, marking him as one of the most decorated leaders in U.S. history. The legacy of Dominion Hill is woven with the extraordinary lives of these remarkable individuals, making it a place steeped in rich stories and grandeur.



Van Horne Room...



Van Fleet Suite...




A deluxe ground floor suite in the 120 year-old Carriage House


The large living room is in the former blacksmith shop that has the original furnace. There are sofas and comfortable chairs, a table for games, Smart TV, fridge and Keurig machine. The main bedroom has a wall of windows, 2 queen size beds and a state-of-the-art massage chair (Medical Breakthrough 6 Plus). The bathroom has a walk-in shower. The second bedroom has a queen bed, ceiling fan and electric fireplace. Amenities include a hot tub, exercise room, fire pit, hiking trails, lawn games, picnic areas, coffee station, food and bar service. Breakfast is complimentary.












THE LOFT IS OUR LARGEST SUITE!

Located in the century-old Carriage House, the suite is on two levels. On the ground floor there is a large entrance foyer, and a private bedroom with a queen bed. There are 1.5 bathrooms on this floor, one with a tub/shower combination. The second floor is a huge room (over 900 sq. ft.) with a cathedral ceiling and old wood beams.

At one end is a kitchen area with dishwasher, microwave, convection oven and stove top. There is a dining room table that can seat 6-12 people, a games table, desk, and four twin beds. The Loft has a large screen TV, and sound system. A large private deck overlooks the property.

FORMER ESTATES HOME FOR VIP GUESTS!




Harmony Cottage was the estate's home for VIP guests. It has a large living room/dining room with a fireplace, large screen TV, comfortable seating and lots of windows. A closet contains a full-size washer and dryer. The galley kitchen has all appliances (range with oven, microwave, dishwasher, fridge) and is equipped with dishes, pots, pans and utensils. The French doors lead to a deck and a large fenced yard.

The second floor has two bedrooms with queen size beds. These rooms have air conditioning and supplemental heating. The bathroom has the original claw-foot tub for bathing and showers.

This cottage provides a safe environment for guests with allergies. The cleaning products used are all natural, there are no fragrances in the soaps or detergents, and guests are asked not to use perfume and strongly scented products.








Lupine Cottage...

Campobello & Harbour Cabin...




The Campobello and Harbour Cabin are situated in a leafy clearing steps from the forest. The queen size bed is complimented by a small seating area, and the private bathroom includes both a bathtub and shower. The cottage is pet friendly and there are lawns and walking trails for Fido. The room is air conditioned with a smart TV and WIFI.









Our new Bell, Explorer and Safari glamping tents have a variety of sleeping options – queen, king, two queens, queen and a twin, queen and bunk beds, with soft mattresses and quality sheets, pine furniture, fans, electric lights, wood pellet stoves and heaters. The glamping tent platforms are in the trees, with a veranda, outdoor chairs and a small enclosure with a portable toilet and sink. A short walk takes you to a new building with showers and toilets in private bathrooms. There is an area for barbecuing and outdoor dining. Our hot tubs under the stars are also nearby.

Our glamping guests have full access to the amenities and receive the complimentary breakfast in the Manor House. We have walking trails for those who want to explore nature and close by is the Digdeguash tidal bay and waterfall.

Glamping is often considered a new concept because the word was only added to the dictionary in 2016. However, historical records and paintings reveal its popularity among the European aristocracy from the 1500's. The English kings and a few hundred friends were known to erect more than a thousand tents for a summer holiday of "glamping", furnishing the compound with beds, tables, chairs, and oriental carpets from their castles. African safaris brought an unprecedented luxury to camping in the early 1920's that has now spread around the globe as "Glamping."
